Adjudicator Update

We are still looking to add more qualified adjudicators to our Adjudicators List. To date, I have only received two applications to be placed on the Probationary Adjudicator List, even though several others have assured me they were going to send in their own application. It is extremely easy to be put on the list; I just need your contact information and which category you fall under to qualify. Remember, it is very easy to qualify; you just need NCTM certification, or a Master's or Terminal degree in piano or piano pedagogy. If you do not fall under one of these categories, you may submit a resume of your professional accomplishments and the accomplishments of your students. I am including the resolution explaining the requirements again in this issue. I hope to hear from many of you to get the process started.

ADOPTED 2/26/2012: Procedure for Attaining the IMTA Adjudicator's Endorsement:

- 1) A teacher must hold MTNA certification or a Master's or Terminal Degree in Piano or Piano Pedagogy or have a Curriculum Vitae (outlining education, professional experience, and student successes) approved by the state board.

Meeting requirement #1 awards the candidate a probationary Adjudicator's Endorsement. This qualifies a teacher to judge festivals.

- 2) A candidate, after meeting one of the above requirements, must adjudicate 3 IMTA Festivals with positive feedback, before being qualified to judge at auditions.

We would really like to encourage Festival Chairs to schedule these judges so they may progress to fully qualified adjudicators. Also, do not forget to submit the evaluation form <https://sites.google.com/site/imtaauditionsplano/home/probationary-judging-evaluation-form> . Once I have three positive evaluations on file, I will move the adjudicator's information to the regular Adjudicators List.

We have had requests from some teachers who are interested in adjudicating but would like some training first. We can discuss this further at the Fall Board Meeting, but our recommendation would be that for those who desire training, that they shadow an experienced adjudicator (minimum 5 years experience, NCTM certified) with that adjudicator's permission and the permission of the site chair. We recommend that the shadowing teacher write their own comments and observations about each student as the day progresses. After the level is completed, the adjudicator and shadow can compare and discuss their respective comments and decisions. This would add some time to the decision-making allotment, but could be kept reasonable (10-15 minutes per level.) Hopefully, this would help some well-qualified teachers to move into the ranks of our adjudicators. Please realize that this is not a requirement, but just an opportunity for those who would like to take advantage of it.

2012-2013 MTNA Student Composition Competition

1. The application form deadline for **all states** is **Wednesday, September 12, 2012**. All applications ***must be submitted online*** before **3:00 pm, (Eastern Time) on September 12, 2012**. Print a copy for your records. The manuscripts will now be uploaded as a PDF file as you register. More information on how to do that will be available sometime in August on the MTNA website. Manuscripts will NO longer be mailed to the State Composition Coordinator.
2. **Online Instructions: Entry fees are nonrefundable and are paid directly to MTNA.**
 1. Go to www.mtna.org
 2. Click on MTNA.
 3. Choose "2012-2013 Competitions Guidelines" from Competitions menu.
 4. Follow the online directions.
3. Entry fees per student for the Composition Competition are as follows:
Elementary: Entry fee: \$50, Age: 5-10 as of January 1, 2013.
Junior High: Entry fee: \$70, Age: 11-14 as of January 1, 2013.
Senior High: Entry fee: \$100, Age: 15-18 as of January 1, 2013.
Young Artist: Entry fee: \$100, Age: 19-26 as of January 1, 2013.
4. Current active membership MUST be paid prior to accessing the student composition application.
5. Entrants must have prepared the composition with the teacher listed on the Official Application Form.
6. A national winner may not participate in the same competition category again.

Student Composition Rules

1. Dues for the teacher for the 2012-2013 year must be paid by August 31, 2012.
2. A student may submit only one entry.
3. A student may enter the competitions in only one state.
4. Only one student per entry is allowed.
5. The performance time may not exceed 10 minutes.
6. Only compositions for nine performers or less will be accepted.
7. Measures of the composition must be numbered, preferably at the beginning of each system.
8. Recordings are NO longer required to enter a score.
9. Manuscripts are to be uploaded as a PDF file to National.
10. No change may be made to the manuscript once it has been submitted with the application.

Please consider entering your student's compositions in the MTNA Composition Competition. It is the intent of this competition to encourage creativity and self-expression in student musicians through the art of composing and to recognize their achievements, as well as the significant work of their teachers. Notes:

- 1) Income from the IMTA Conference 2012 will arrive within a few weeks and should total over \$7,000.00. This will bring the Total Loss down to around \$2,000.00 rather than \$8,379.73.
- 2) An anticipated Conference 2012 loss of around \$2,300.00 is attributed to subsidizing 30 rooms at \$25.00 per night (\$1,100.00), 63 picnic suppers at \$8.00 per person (\$559.00), and 68 banquet dinners at \$1.84 per person (\$125.00). Also, hospitality (coffee and cookies) came to \$830.00. A huge thank you to **Alan Huckleberry** and **Allison Chenoweth** for your outstanding work on this year's conference.
- 3) The IMT Magazine loss appears to be much less than in former years, although I don't have exact figures. Congratulations to magazine editor **Theresa Camilli** and advertising editor **Nicole Green** for your work to keep expenses low and income high.
- 4) Student travel was higher this year because a four-student ensemble traveled to MTNA Divisional and National Competitions (\$2,000.00), and a University of Iowa student team presented a workshop at the MTNA National Conference (\$1,000.00).
