Money Matters: Summer IMTA Treasury Notes 2013

Happy summer! My second year as IMTA Treasurer has been more calm and predictable than the first, as I've come to understand my responsibilities more fully. I accepted incoming President Alan Huckleberry's invitation to commit myself to another two years of service to this position.

I am very grateful for the patience, understanding, and cooperation of everyone in IMTA as I continue to organize and manage our bookkeeping system. Special thanks go to past treasurers Bob Ramsey and Deanne Tibben, president Donita McCoy, magazine editor Theresa Camilli, syllabus sales coordinator Pat Reuter Riddle, Auditions chairs Deb Ausborn and Rachel McCoy, MTNA Competitions chair Diane Smith, Festivals chair Karen Bourne, advertising editor Nicole Green, Conference 2012 and 2013 chairs Alan Huckleberry and Allison Chenoweth, webmaster Jason Sifford and all local Auditions and Festival chairs for your generous assistance and kind support.

This article contains the two treasury proposals that were passed by the IMTA Board at the June 3, 2013 Board meeting, and miscellaneous information such as judges' fees, mileage rates, judges' food allotment for Auditions and Festivals, personal printing rates, and travel stipends. You can find my full treasury report and passed budget on the IMTA website at <http://iamta.org/>. The Fiscal Report and 2013-14 Budget will be published in the Fall IMT Magazine.

A) Proposals Passed by the IMTA Board on June 3, 2013:

1. IMTA will spend down the Vanguard Money Market savings rather than increase member fees or decrease spending to cover possible future budget shortfalls. (No money was withdrawn from this account this past year.)
2. The 2013-14 IMTA Budget is passed with the projected losses.

B) Miscellaneous Information:

1. 2013-14 Judges' Fees: \$28.00/hour
2. 2013-14 Mileage Reimbursement: \$.51/mile
3. Judges' Food Allotment for Auditions and Festivals: \$10.00 per judge
4. Personal Printing Reimbursement: \$.10/copy
5. MTNA Divisional Competitions Student Travel: \$200.00 per student
6. MTNA National Competitions Travel: \$300.00 per student
7. The Board encourages local associations to budget student travel expenses for MTNA Competitions (Feb. 26, 2012).
8. New forms are planned for 2013-14: District and State Auditions Financial Reports, Festival Financial Report, Personal Printing Expense Form, IMTA Expense Voucher, State Conference Financial Report.
9. Iowa membership (and, thus, income) increased from last year. Iowa membership for the last five years is as follows (from Elaine A. Donaldson, 5-22-13): 2008-09: 401; 2009-10: 388; 2010-11: 363; 2011-12: 362; 2012-13: 374.
10. IMTA received thank you notes from Stephanie March, Leah McIntire-Barnett, Jonathan Wolf, and James Skretta for their \$200.00 and \$300.00 student travel stipends to MTNA Divisional and National Competitions.

- The application form deadline for all states is **Wednesday, September 11, 2013**. All applications **must be submitted online** before **3:00 pm, (Eastern Time) on September 11, 2013**. Print a copy for your records. The manuscripts will now be uploaded as a PDF file as you register. More information on how to do that will be available sometime in August on the MTNA website. Manuscripts will NO longer be mailed to the State Composition Coordinator.
- Online Instructions: Entry fees are nonrefundable and are paid directly to MTNA.
 - Go to www.mtna.org
 - Click on MTNA.
 - Choose "2013-2014 Competitions Guidelines" from Competitions menu.
 - Follow the online directions.
- Entry fees per student for the Composition Competition are as follows:
 - Elementary:** Entry fee: \$50, Age: 5-10 as of January 1, 2014.
 - Junior High:** Entry fee: \$70, Age: 11-14 as of January 1, 2014.
 - Senior High:** Entry fee: \$100, Age: 15-18 as of January 1, 2014.
 - Young Artist:** Entry fee: \$100, Age: 19-26 as of January 1, 2014.
- Current active membership **MUST** be paid prior to accessing the student composition application.
- Entrants must have prepared the composition with the teacher listed on the Official Application Form.
- A national winner may not participate in the same competition category again.

Student Composition Rules

- Dues for the teacher for the 2013-2014 year must be paid by August 31, 2013.

- Manuscripts are to be uploaded as a PDF file to National.
- No change may be made to the manuscript once it has been submitted with the application..
